Food Arrangements

Dinner Friday, breakfast, lunch and dinner Saturday, and breakfast Sunday will be served buffet style in the dining hall. All campers age 6 and up will be asked to help with one meal during camp. All meals are included with the registration fee, however we ask that each family bring one large snack (sweet or savory) to be shared by all during camp. In addition, you may bring non-perishable snacks your family/group would enjoy. Special dietary foods requiring refrigeration may be stored in the kitchen and must be marked. Bring your favorite beverage mug and/or water bottle. Camp cups and glasses may not be taken from the dining hall.

1. Please indicate any allergies or special dietary needs. We will do our best to accommodate. In the past each meal has had a vegan option, help us plan qualities by telling us if you plan to eat vegan or vegetarian.

Sleeping Accommodations

Cornet Bay ELC has cabins that sleep 10-14 people. Cabins are equipped with mattress and bunks. Bring your own bedding or sleeping bags and pillows. In most cases shower and toilet facilities are separate from sleeping quarters. We anticipate grouping people as listed below.

- Cabins shared between two families, generally with children
- Cabins shared between three couples, generally without children
- Adult men's cabin
- Adult women's cabin
- Rooms for families with infants (these two cabins with rooms for 2-4 people will be made available first come, first served to parents with infants)

Dinner will be at 6:00 pm. Upon arrival please report to the dining hall for check-in, cabin assignment and meal assignment.

Driving Directions

From the Keystone Ferry take a left onto Engle Road (Do not follow signs to Coupeville as this will take you 8 miles out of your way). Engle Road will turn into Main Street as you enter Coupeville.

Turn left onto Highway 20 and drive approximately 19 miles to Deception Pass State Park. At the stoplight turn right onto Cornet Bay Road. Follow Cornet Bay road .4 miles and look for the signs on the left hand side of the road for Cornet Bay Environmental Learning Center.
